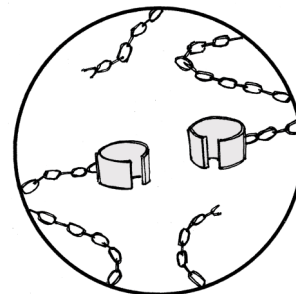


Lesson #4-31***Rejoicing in the Good News***

**Key Verse:**

The Point:

God can even use the imprisonment of the faithful to bring about change in people.

Unit Theme (April 1—April 22):

Good News Spreads

Superheroes for Jesus

We can be brave like Paul and Silas.

You will need:

- † Activity sheet
- † Crayons or markers
- † Safety pins
- † Scissors
- † Optional: label paper

Preparation:

1. Make copies of the activity sheet. You could cut out the emblems to save time. You could also print them on label paper to make stickers.

Instructions:

1. **Who is your favorite superhero? Why?**

What makes a good superhero?

2. **Paul and Silas were like superheroes in today's story. They were superheroes for Jesus. They spread his message of love and peace to all people.**
3. Give the students a copy of the superhero emblem to color. Help them cut it out and pin it to their shirts.
4. **We can be superheroes, too. What are some of the things we can do to be superheroes for Jesus?** [*Love and help others, sharing, telling his story, etc.*]
5. **We can tell people about Jesus and help them become superheroes for Jesus with us. Together we can make the world a better place!**
