The Point:

Opening Prayer

You will need:

- † Scrabble® sets
- † Table

Preparation:

- 1. Set up one or more tables where worshippers enter the worship space. Place Scrabble® boards and tiles at each. Set out a starter word on each board.
- 2. Station someone at the table or make a small sign instructing people to use the Scrabble pieces to list something that God has created. Their addition must build off a word already on the table.
- 3. Ask adults to help younger kids participate.

- Using the word cloud created by worshippers as the entered, invite worshippers to join in this opening prayer.
