



# What is Biblical Fluency?

## Scripture Passage

Joshua 24:1-15 [16-26]

## Key Verse:

As for me and my household, we will serve the LORD.  
Joshua 24:15b

## The Point:

We are called to be faithful in serving God.

## The Story of Our Lives

*Finding God's presence in the events of daily life.*

### Supplies:

- † Paper
- † Pens or pencils

### Instructions:

1. Read aloud this or another Bible story.
2. Divide participants into small groups to discuss the following: **What difference does hearing today's Scripture passage make for your daily life? What is the important thing you will remember?**
3. **How is your faith similar to the faith of your parents? How is it different?**
4. **Sometimes it is easier to see God at work in someone else's life than in our own. Who do you see God at work in or through? What about their life catches your attention?**
5. **What stories do you remember your parents or grandparents telling about you as a baby or a small child? If you were going to write a list of God's activities on your behalf during those years, what "I \_\_\_\_" statements would you write for God?**
6. After you feel participants have had a good chance to converse, set aside 3-5 minutes for them to create their own "responses." This might be in the form of words (such as a journal of thoughts), it might be a drawing, song lyrics, poem, etc. The idea is for them to create a way to record their thoughts regarding this story and what God is doing in their life today.



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
