Mercy, Justice, and Peace Micah [1:3-5] 5:2-5a; 6:6-8



Key Verse:

What does the LORD require of you but to do justice, and to love kindness, and to walk humbly with your God? Micah 6:8

The Point:

God's promised shepherd will bring peace and teach us to lead lives of justice and mercy.

Unit Theme (November 11—November 25)
