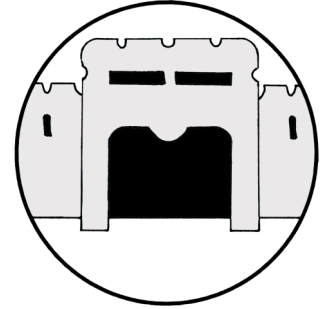


Lesson #1-12*Jeremiah's Call*

Jeremiah 1:4-10; 7:1-11

**Key Verse:**

For I am with you to deliver you, says the LORD.

Jeremiah 1:8

The Point:

We are equipped to serve God and called to live in ways that bring peace.

Unit Theme (November 11—November 25)

God's Plan for Peace

*Young Leaders**You will need:*

Preparation:

1. Groups will complete an Activity Sheet for a young person that they know. You may create a sample from a well-known or little-known young leader to demonstrate.

Instructions:

1. **The prophet Jeremiah was called into ministry as a young man. In honor of the calling of young people, we are going to share information about a young person who serves as a role model for us.**
2. Ask participants to divide into small groups.

3. Hand out Activity Sheets, one per group.
4. **Often young people are overlooked or underestimated, but we need to keep reminding ourselves that people of all ages are equal in God's eyes. Sometimes the best person for a job is a young person. You are going to create a profile of a young person in our congregation or community. You can even profile someone in your group!**
5. **When you are finished, discuss the following questions in your group:**
 - a. **What stands out to you about this person?**
 - b. **How is this person a good leader?**
 - c. **Is there anything about this person that reminds you of yourself?**
 - d. **How can we learn from this person?**
