
Lesson #1-12

Preparation:

 Groups will complete an Activity Sheet for a young person that they know. You may create a sample from a well-known or little-know young leader to demonstrate.

Instructions:

- 1. The prophet Jeremiah was called into ministry as a young man. In honor of the calling of young people, we are going to share information about a young person who serves as a role model for us.
- 2. Ask participants to divide into small groups.

- 3. Hand out Activity Sheets, one per group.
- 4. Often young people are overlooked or underestimated, but we need to keep reminding ourselves that people of all ages are equal in God's eyes. Sometimes the best person for a job is a young person. You are going to create a profile of a young person in our congregation or community. You can even profile someone in your group!
- 5. When you are finished, discuss the following questions in your group:
 - a. What stands out to you about this person?
 - b. How is this person a good leader?
 - c. Is there anything about this person that reminds you of yourself?
 - d. How can we learn from this person?
