Key Verse:

An account of the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

Matthew 1:1

The Point:

God fulfills promises and provides us with guidance and protection.

You will need:

Instructions:

- 1. Sometimes it is helpful to reflect on a story in our current context, shifting the events to a familiar time and place.
- 2. Look together at the reading from Matthew 2. As you read, write down people, methods of travel and communication, gifts given, and places

mentioned in the story.

- 3. As small groups, brainstorm replacements for the list you have made that would bring the story into our context. For example, the Magi might have followed GPS rather than a star. Jesus' family may have fled as refugees to somewhere other than Egypt.
- 4. Select a scribe and together rewrite the "news" story with your changes.
- 5. What was it like to reflect upon the story in this way? Did it make you think about the Epiphany story differently? How did you connect it to current events?
