Key Verse:

Now Sarah said, "God has brought laughter for me; everyone who hears will laugh with me."

Genesis 21:6

The Point:

God gives us joy when God fulfills promises.

Unit Theme (September 26—September 22)

The Promise of a Son

God fulfills promises in unexpected ways.

You will need:

Instructions:

- 1. Divide into small groups. Have each group read Genesis 18:1-15 and 21:1-7 in their small groups. Allow them to choose how to read it. Do not allow them to read silently, as that would leave out pre-readers.
- 2. Assign each group a few verses (depending on the number of groups you have).
- 3. We are going to tell this story by creating a freeze frame, like a photo, of the verses that you have been given. When I read the story again, you will get into your freeze frame when I get to your verses. Together our scenes will tell the

story. Two simple rules: you must use every person in your group, and you cannot say anything or move when you are doing your scene.

- 4. Note: make adjustments to these instructions if you have individuals of differing abilities.
- 5. Read the story, allowing the groups to create their freeze frames. Do it again if time allows.
- 6. Discuss the following:
 - What do you think Abraham thought of the strange visitors? How did he react? How do you show hospitality to visitors?
 - How would you feel if you had to wait until you were 100 years old to have a promise fulfilled? How did Sarah react?
 - Reread 18:14a. What do you think? Can you think of anything that is too difficult for God?
