# Serving Refugees

In each Living the Word: Small Groups guide (as with all of our main products), we include instructions on how to do a particular faith practice related to the day's Bible reading.

For the past three weeks our small group discussion guides have suggested creating a service project related to refugees, as the people of Israel were in fleeing slavery in Egypt, and now Naomi's family escaping a devastating famine.

Within a single worship service, group meeting, or class, you probably will not have time to research, plan, and implement a full service project, you can look at the following suggestions.

Take time to teach about or have participants research this topic.

- What is a refugee?
- What are some of the needs of refugees or special requests from groups that support refugees?
- What can your congregation or individual participants do to help (or what are you already doing)?

If possible, create a concrete plan to serve the needs of refugees and follow up in the coming weeks.

Possible sources: United Nations Refugee Agency, International Rescue Committee (IRC), American Refugee Committee, and Lutheran Immigration and Refugee Service. Your denomination might have their own organization as well.
