# Building Elijah's Alkar

Follow Elijah's instructions to build an altar.

#### You will need:

- † Small stones
- † Small sticks
- † Strips of red tissue paper
- † Small squares of blue tissue paper

#### Instructions:

- 1. In our story today, Elijah built a special place to give offerings to God called an altar. Let's work together to build a version of Elijah's altar.
- 2. For each step, select participants to act out the task described.
- 3. First, we need to stack these twelve stones to build the base of the altar.
- 4. Next, we need to add the wood (sticks) to Elijah's altar.

- 5. Then, we need to fill four cups with water. Have cups pre-filled with blue tissue paper "water." Pour the water over the altar.
- 6. After Elijah built his altar, he prayed to God to send fire. Let's all pray together: Dear God, please send fire. Amen.
- 7. **Did God send the fire?** Of course! distribute red tissue paper strips to all participants and lead participants in covering the altar with it as if it were the fire sent by God. The fire burned everything up, and all the people there fell down and shouted, "The Lord indeed is God!"
- 8. Let's say it all together now: the Lord indeed is God!
- 9. Note: Adjust the altar size as appropriate for your context. You may also have small groups each create their own altar.
