
- 1. In our story today, we hear about a man who was very sick. The people that he knew, his friends, his family, his neighbors, were all scared of him.

- 5. Here are some ways we can greet people and help them feel welcome. Go over the four ways of greeting each other that are listed on the Activity Sheet.
- 6. Whenever we touch someone else, especially giving a hug, it's important that we ask the other person if it is okay. So, you would say, "Welcome! Can I give you a hug or a handshake?" If you do not want to be touched, you can just wave to a person and give them a smile.




