

Lesson #2-21***A Woman Healed, A Girl Raised***

Mark 5:21-43

**Key Verse:**

[Jesus] said to her, "Daughter, your faith has made you well, go in peace, and be healed of your disease."

Mark 5:34

The Point:

Jesus has power to heal and bring life.

Unit Theme (January 26—February 23)

The Power of the Kingdom

Film-Strip Bible Bookmarks

Creating a physical reminder of Jesus' power to heal and give life.

Supplies:

- › Heavy paper (card stock)
- › Ribbon or yarn
- › Card stock
- › Pens or pencils
- › Markers
- › Rulers
- › Scissors
- › Hole punch
- › Optional: old magazines, glue

Preparation:

1. Make a film-strip Bible bookmark to use as a sample. You may want to search online to see samples of film-strip bookmarks.

Instructions:

1. Give each participant a sheet of cardstock. They can use a ruler to measure the size for their bookmarks. Bookmarks can be any size, but 8.5" x 2" is a good general guideline.
2. Cut out the bookmarks.
3. Ask the participants to divide the bookmark into four frames. Each pane will tell a part of today's Bible story.
4. Optional: participants may choose to tell a personal story of how God answered prayer or worked in their life or the life of someone they know rather than using the Bible story.
5. Instruct the participants to fill the frames with the various parts of the story. To retell the story, they can draw, write, or glue pictures and words from the magazines. Suggest they include a reference to a Scripture verse in each frame.
6. Use a hole punch to punch a hole at the top of the bookmark. Thread ribbon or yarn through the hole and tie it.
