Think about devotions is as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

♣ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

God, you sent your people to the ends of the earth to share your love with everybody. Send us now, your disciples, to be your love and grace and mercy to a world in need. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- Highs & Lows: Is there something that you did today that made you really happy?
 Is there something that you did today that made you really sad?
- Thinking About This Week's Story: Some people heard about Jesus' love from Paul and Silas, and they happily believed it. Others were unhappy with it. What news did you hear today? Did it make you happy or unhappy?
- **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** Paul spent time building tents with his friends. Name one thing that you built today.

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

♣ Name one thing that made you sad today and pray about it.

CLOSING

₱ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

Particular Rituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

Mark one another with the sign of the cross on each other's hands or forehead, and say, "May you go, help, and love others today. Amen."
