


Lesson #2-37

Many Gifts, One Spirit

Acts 2:1-4; 1 Corinthians 12:1-13



Key Verse:

To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good. 1 Corinthians 12:7

The Point:

Each of us is given gifts by the Holy Spirit to serve others.

Unit Theme (May 17—May 31)

The Power of God's Love

Building the Body

Discuss giftedness.

You will need:

- † Modeling clay or play dough
- † Hand wipes

Instructions:

- 1. This activity is designed to be an introduction to the Scripture lessons of the day. It is recommended that you do this activity and then read the Scripture listed above.
- 2. Divide the clay or play dough so that each person has a piece.
- 3. In this discussion, the youngest person in your family should go first, and then they can invite whoever they would like to go next. Each person should invite the next person to speak.
- 4. As you talk, your family will build a clay person together. As they are speaking, each person will

- create one part, then the next speaker will add on to that part. By the time the last person speaks, the clay person should be finished.
- 5. While you build, discuss the following questions.
 - Has anyone ever told you that you are good at something? What is it? Do you agree with them?
 - Is there anything you feel you are good at that you do not think anyone notices?
- 6. Say: Our story today is about the many different ways that people in the church are gifted through the Holy Spirit. We are different parts of a body, just like we each created an important part of our clay person.
- 7. Note; adapt this activity to the supplies you have available. Be creative!
