#### **Gathering**

**Monday** 

Read Matthew 9:35–10:8 [9-23] Jesus sends out the twelve apostles. Say: These are the names of the disciples... and say your names.

#### **Prayer of the Week**

God, you name us as your disciples. Send us out to tell others about your love in word and action. Amen.

#### Go

God encourages Joshua. Reread the second part of verse 9. Where do you need courage?

#### **Daily Check-in**

When did you show compassion or kindness today? When did you feel harassed or helpless?

#### Read 1 Samuel 3:1-9

Read Joshua 1:1-11

God calls Samuel.

Read Luke 6:12-19

#### **Daily Bible Readings**

Read aloud the Daily Bible Reading from the right. If your household includes younger children, use a child-friendly Bible. You might find that the children's Bible you are using may not include the story selected. Read to your kids anyway. Just pick a story!

#### Tuesday

What is one thing that you think God is urging you to do?

#### Wednesday

Jesus names the apostles and heals many. How do you think God heals people today?

#### **Discussion Starters**

What would you want to bring on a journey? How would you react if you were not allowed to bring anything?

### Read Psalm 69:7-10, 16-18

The psalmist calls out to God. When have you felt lonely or like a stranger?

#### **Praying Together**

Share with each other someone who is sick or in need of help. Pray together for God's healing and peace for each of them.

The apostles are sent to jail. What is something that might make people feel trapped? How can you help them feel free?
