# **Gathering**

Begin your devotions by doing something to mark this time as "God time," like lighting a candle or singing a song.

# **Prayer of the Week**

God, when we look at the trouble all around us, we often become afraid. Please give us faith like Peter's and beyond. Reach out and catch us when we fall. Amen.

# **Daily Check-in**

When have you been afraid, anxious, or nervous today? When have you been confident?

# **Daily Bible Readings**

Read aloud the Daily Bible Reading on the right. If your household includes younger children, use a child-friendly Bible. You might find that the children's Bible you are using may not include the story selected. Read to your kids anyway. Just pick a story!

## **Discussion Starters**

Peter had such faith in Jesus that he was willing to get out of the boat in a high wind. Why do you think Jesus said that he had little faith?

## **Praying Together**

Ask each person to name something that they are afraid of in the future and something they are confident about. Pray for these things.

# **Blessing for the Week**

End your devotions by tracing a cross on each person's forehead or hand with their permission and saying: **Take heart, and do not be afraid.** 

## Read Matthew 14:22-33

Jesus walks on water.

Imagine that you do not know this story, and you are in the boat with the disciples. How would you feel?

## Read Psalm 18:1-6

**Monday** David is in danger. In a time when you

## Read Psalm 18:6-19

God arrives to rescue David. Why do you think David described God rescuing him this way? [None of the stories in 1 Samuel describe this.]

### Read Matthew 8:23-27

Iesus calms the storm.

Pretend you are in a boat in a storm by making sounds and motions. Stop when the youngest person says, "Stop!"

#### Read Psalm 67

May God bless us.
Say to each other, "may God bless you."
Each person responds, "Praise God."

#### Read Acts 14:19-28

Paul and Barnabas travel. Where have you traveled to?

#### Read Matthew 14:34-36

Jesus heals many. What would you tell other people if you

saw Jesus?
