Gathering

Begin your devotions by doing something to mark this time as "God time," like lighting a candle or singing a song.

Read Matthew 15:[10-20], 21-28 Jesus and the Canaanite Woman Name one thing you can do this week to help one other person.

Daily Check-in

When have you been annoyed today? When have you been kind to others?

Read Psalm 87

A song about Zion. Zion is another name for Jerusalem where God's temple was. Why do you think the songwriter was so happy?

Daily Bible Readings

Read aloud the Daily Bible Reading on the right. If your household includes younger children, use a child-friendly Bible. You might find that the children's Bible you are using may not include the story selected. Read to your kids anyway. Just pick a story!

Read Matthew 8:1-13

Read 1 Corinthians 6:1-11

Read 2 Corinthians 10:12-18

Iesus heals two outsiders. The man with a skin disease and the Roman officer were outsiders. Who are some outsiders today?

Discussion Starters

Jesus usually welcomes people's pleas for help, but here he at first rejects a woman's request because she is not Jewish. What is your reaction to this?

Arguments between believers. What can you do to peacefully resolve arguments between family members or friends this week?

Praying Together

Ask each person to name at least one person or situation that needs God's help. Respond to each request: Have mercy, Lord.

Speak with pride about what God does. Where do you see God working in the world?

Blessing for the Week

End your devotions by tracing a cross on each person's forehead or hand with their permission and saying: Lord, help [person's name].
