Daily Check-in

Read Romans 11:33-36

Glory be to God forever. God is so much greater than we are, yet God also loves us without limit. Take a moment to reflect on this.

Daily Bible Readings

Read aloud the Daily Bible Reading on the right. If your household includes younger children, use a child-friendly Bible. You might find that the children's Bible you are using may not include the story selected. Read to your kids anyway. Just pick a story!

Discussion Starters
