The Point:

We can never out-give God, no matter how hard we try.

Unit Theme (September 13—October 25)

Promises Made, Promises Broken

Space for Worship

Create a special space at home or church.

Supplies:

- > Prayer space items
- > Paper
- > Pens or pencils
- > Optional: small tent; blanket, chairs, or similar

Preparation:

- 1. Prepare as much or as little as you desire: select one or more options for a worship space. This can be temporary or permanent.
- 2. Gather or list various items available that can be used to set this space apart.
- 3. If you are using a small tent or "blanket fort," have those items set up or ready.

Instructions:

1. We know that God is not limited by space. The whole earth belongs to God, and God

- can be worshipped anywhere. The Israelites learned this in the wilderness when they worshipped God in a tent that they could put up and take down as they traveled from place to place. We can remind ourselves of God's presence with a special space like that tent. We can visit this space to pray and reflect.
- 2. Work together to create and decorate this worship space. If there are items that you do not have but would like to obtain, write a list and make a plan to obtain them.
- 3. If you will use this activity in person, create a safe space for the whole congregation to use, complying with all local health guidelines. This would likely be outdoors.
