


Lesson #3-R1

Jesus Has Risem! Luke 24:1-12



Key Verse:

"Why do you look for the living among the dead? He is not here, but has risen." Luke 24:5

The Point:

Women proclaim the news that Jesus has risen from the dead.

Unit Theme (April 4—May 23)

Birth of the Church

Empty Tomb Rolls

Bake simple rolls.

Supplies:

- † Crescent rolls
- † Large marshmallows
- † Melted butter
- † Cinnamon
- † Small dish or plate
- † Baking pan

Preparation:

- 1. Melt butter and mix with cinnamon. Place a small amount in the dish.
- 2. Preheat oven following the directions for the crescent rolls.
- 3. Participants assemble the rolls as you speak, with a break while the crescent rolls bake. You may plan another activity while you wait.

Instructions:

- 1. Hold up the marshmallow. **Jesus is going to be** symbolized by this marshmallow. After Jesus died on the cross he was wrapped in fine linens. Roll marshmallow in butter and cinnamon.
- 2. **Jesus was put into the tomb.** Wrap the marshmallow in crescent dough.
- 3. Bake rolls according to package instructions.
- 4. Hand out the rolls once they have cooled.
- 5. On the third day, Jesus rose and was no longer in the tomb. Open the roll, which will be hollow. The tomb was empty. Jesus was not there!
- 6. Enjoy the snack together.
