God Wants Me To...

How does God want us to act?

You will need:

- † Mural paper
- Markers or crayons
- Bible

Preparation:

1. On a large sheet of mural paper, make three sections: Watching & Listening to Other People, Traditions, and Learning from the Bible.

Instructions:

1. In today's story, we see that the disciples learned how God wants them to act. We can break this into three categories: watching

- and listening to other people, traditions, and learning from the Bible.
- 2. Let's think about what you learn from each of these categories.
 - How do we learn about God from watching and listening to other people?
 - How do we learn about God from participating in and studying traditions?
 - How do we learn about God from looking in the Bible?
- 3. Write or draw your answers in the three sections on the paper. Work alongside the participants, helping brainstorm ideas as necessary.
- 4. Display the mural in your space.
