


Lesson #3-34

Compare parallel versions of the story.

You will need:

- † Internet-connected devices
- † Paper
- † Pens or pencils
- † Tape
- † Optional: printer

Instructions:

- 1. We are going to take some time to compare different versions of this story from different translations of the Bible.
- 2. Invite volunteers to find different translations of Galatians 3:23-29 online on sites such as BibleGateway.com. Optional: print out a variety of translation beforehand.

- 3. After reading each version aloud, ask:
 - What specific words or phrases stand out for you in this translation?
 - What did you hear this time that you did not notice last time?
- 4. In spite of our differences, when we come together, we create the church. It may look different to each of us, but that is part of the beauty of the church.
- 5. Think for a moment of an image that you feel describes or defines the church. Use the paper provided to draw your image.
- 6. When everyone has their image, ask them to share what this represents. Tape the smaller images together to represent the church.
