DEVOTIONS

Think about devotions as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

♣ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

The voice cries out in the wilderness, "Prepare the way of the Lord." Dear God, help us to be that voice, to tell others about your birth and about your love for this world. Thank you for giving us the faith to do just that. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- Highs & Lows: Name one thing that made you happy today. Name one thing that made you sad.
- Thinking about This Week's Story: John announces several things about Jesus including his coming into the world, his baptism and his testimony about Jesus being the Son of God. How have you represented Jesus in your life today? How have you not represented Jesus today?
- **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** Jesus calls the disciples to follow him. Jesus calls you, too, to be his disciples. How have you followed Jesus today?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

[⊕] Say together: Baptized into the faith of God, help us to share God's love with others. Amen.

CLOSING

₱ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

PRituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

With permission, mark one another with the sign of the cross each other's hands or forehead with water, and say, "Go and tell others about the Son of God. Amen."
