# **DEVOTIONS**

God of promise, Noah was not a perfect human being. But he was a man who listened to you and believed what you promised. Help us to hear, to believe and to rest in the peace of your promises. Amen.

## CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- **Highs & Lows:** What made you smile today? What made you frown today?
- Thinking about This Week's Story: Noah and his family must have been scared on the ark but turned joyful when they received God's promise. What made you scared or uncomfortable today? What has brought you joy?
- **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** God is on the move in this story. What is one fun thing had you on the move today? What did you do?

## **DAILY BIBLE READING**

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

## **PRAY TOGETHER**

Dear God, your love makes me feel	Being with the people that care
for me makes me feel	Thank you for your love and for the people
that love me. Amen.	

# **CLOSING**

₱ If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.
