## NO DOUBT GAME

Play Red Light, Green Light with a twist.

#### You will need:

## Instructions:

- 1. This game will be played like Red Light, Green Light.
- 2. Choose one person to be It. Have the rest of the class behind a starting line on the other side of the room.
- 3. Today we heard the story about Jesus being alive again. Thomas had a hard time believing this story, because at first he was not there to see it for himself. We are going to play a simple game to help us remember that Jesus is alive.
- 4. How many of you know how to play Red Light, Green Light? This game is just like

- that, but with different words. When the person who is It is facing the class, they will say, "Jesus is dead." You will all respond with "I doubt it!" and stay in your places.
- 5. When the person who is It turns their back, they will say "Jesus is alive." You will respond with "No doubt!" and try to move forward.
- 6. As soon as the person who is It turns back around and says, "Jesus is dead," you need to freeze and respond with "I doubt it!" The game continues until someone gets close enough to tag the person who is It.
- 7. Play as long as time allows.
