

Philippians 1:1-18a



Key Verse:

I thank my God every time I remember you. Philippians 1:3

The Point:

The proclamation of the gospel brings joy and thanksgiving even in difficult circumstances.

Unit Theme (May 15—June 5)

Living in Hope

MURAL OF THANKFULNESS

Create a mural of thankfulness.

Supplies:

- † Mural paper or large sheet of paper
- † Markers
- † Optional: tape

Preparation:

1. Set up one or more places for worshippers to add names to several sheets of mural paper either by taping them to the wall or setting them on tables.

Instructions:

- 1. Paul says that he thanks God every time he remembers the Philippians.
- 2. Take a moment to share with those around you about a person or people who

have been an encouragement to you, just as Paul encouraged the Philippians. What did the person do that was encouraging? How did it make a difference?

- 3. Allow worshippers time to share.
- 4. These are people for which we thank God every time we remember them. We can also give thanks and pray for special and important people in our own lives.
- 5. Come forward as you are ready and write the names or initials of people you thank God for on the large sheets of paper. As you write their name, say a prayer for that person and thank God that they have been in your life.
- 6. This activity can also be easily adapted to contexts outside of worship.
