

Decorating Ideas

- Create a waterfall from a corner of the room down to the floor. Use stacked boxes to give it dimension. Cover the boxes with various shades of blue fabric, plastic table covering, iridescent wrapping paper, or recycled bubble wrap.
- Paint seaweed on the lower section of windows, right above the floor. Add blue waves above, sea creatures, etc.
- Create seaweed cutouts from cardboard or insulation foam board, and paint them green. Hang blue and white balloons from the ceiling as water bubbles.
- Hang various shades of blue crepe paper streamers from hallway ceilings, with longer ones along the walls. Add colorful fish along the walls.
- Hang iridescent wrapping paper strips from doorway headers for participants to walk through, or shower curtains from door headers of water or fish patterns, or varying shades of blues.
- Use water play or safety items (rings, floats, etc.) as accents in corners or against pillars and support poles.
- Create a backdrop with five sections, each one representing a lesson. These can be painted, collages, or made of symbolic materials (for example, a shower current with an underwater theme, gray cloth for a storm, etc.). Add one section each day.
