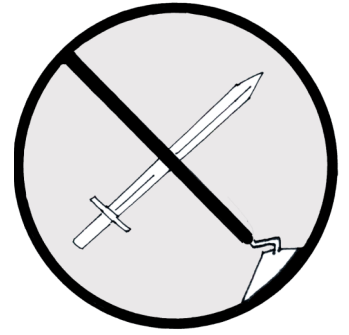


Lesson #1-11

Instructions:

1. Today we will hear a story about King Hezekiah and the prophet Isaiah. In this story, the Assyrian army invades King Hezekiah's land and things get tough for the people of Judah.
2. When times get tough, who do you trust to help you get through it? Let's make a list of these people. *[Parents, friends, pastors, teachers, grandparents, etc.]*
3. How would you feel if I told you that you could not trust these people to help you? *[Angry, sad, confused, etc.]*
4. In today's story, the Assyrians tell the people of Judah that they could not trust King Hezekiah or God to lead them when times were tough. Hezekiah wanted the people to trust in God to deliver them from the Assyrians, and he turns to the prophet Isaiah for advice.
