


Lesson #1-12**WAITING AND WATCHING**

Habakkuk 1:1-7; 2:1-4; 3:[3b-6], 17-19

**Key Verse:**

Look at the proud! Their spirit is not right in them, but the righteous live by their faith.

Habakkuk 2:4

The Point:

Though waiting can be difficult, God always hears our prayers and responds.

Unit Theme (November 27—December 18)

Faith in God's Promises

PRAYER CARDS

Make cards for guided prayer.

Supplies:

- † Index cards
- † Pens or pencils
- † Single hole punch
- † Small binder rings

Instructions:

1. **Prayer is easy for some but can be difficult for many. It is easy to pray sometimes, but hard to pray all the time. It can be a challenge to pray without seeing God's answer. Sometimes it can be a challenge knowing what to pray or how to pray it.**
2. **We are going to make prayer cards to use as a guide for praying during the week. You will be able to flip through the cards as you pray. You can pray one card a day. Or you can pray through each of the cards every day. That is up to you, but try to pray at least once a day this week using your prayer cards.**
3. Give each participant at least seven index cards.
4. As a group, brainstorm what to write on the cards. Alternate between asking for relief for victims of a specific injustice or other difficulties and rejoicing in God's faithfulness.
5. Allow time for the participants to engage in silent prayer as they practice using their prayer cards.
