Key Verse:

"She will bear a son, and you are to name him Jesus, for he will save his people from their sins." Matthew 1:21

The Point:

God's plans may surprise us.

Unit Theme (November 27—December 18)

Faith in God's Promises

WHAT'S IN A NAME

The meanings of names are important.

You will need:

- **†** Bible
- **†** Baby name books or website
- **†** Optional: Internet-connected device

Preparation:

1. You may look up the meanings of the names of your participants in the baby name book or website or do so in class.

Instructions:

1. Parents often spent a lot of time deciding what they would name their children. They might choose names that they liked based on how they sounded, who they reminded them

of, or what the names mean. Names can have a lot of important meanings.

- 2. Either help participants find their names in the baby name book or on a website or share what you looked up before class.
- 3. Jesus' name had meanings, too. If we look in Matthew 1:21 and 23, the angel tells Joseph that the baby should be named Jesus and would be called Emmanuel. Emmanuel means "God is with us." God had promised to send a Messiah. Who was the Messiah that God sent as a baby? [Jesus.] "Jesus" means "savior," and "messiah" means "anointed one" because Jesus was anointed—chosen by God—to save God's people from their sins.
