Think about devotions is as a continuation of our community's worship. The following basic pattern could be one way of forming your household's devotions. Adapt as necessary!

GATHERING

♣ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

† Prayer of the Week

Creating God, with a word you created all that is. From deep, life-giving soil, you have molded and shaped all living things. You have set us in the middle of it all to tend and to care for what you have made. Remind us that you do indeed care for the earth, that we too might share in that caring. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- **Highs & Lows:** What is one good thing that happened today? What is one not-so-good thing that happened?
- Thinking about This Week's Story: God made everything in creation including people, and as God's people we are to help one another. Can you name one way that you helped someone today? Can you name something that was not helpful today?
- **Getting Ready for Next Week's Story:** Sarah laughs when God announces that she will have a son. Did you hear something today that made you laugh? What was it?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

[⊕] Have each person fill in the blank of this prayer: Dear God, thank you for [name one person] because [say why you are thankful for that person]. Amen.

CLOSING

If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.

Parallel Rituals & Traditions: A Blessing to Share

With permission, mark one another with the sign of the cross each other's hands or forehead, and say, "You have been created by God to care for all creation.

Amen."
