

The Point:

When we serve others, we serve Jesus himself.

Unit Theme (February 22—March 26)

The Ways of the Kingdom

SERVANT'S HEART

Imagine what makes a servant's heart.

You will need:

- † Air-drying clay
- Toothpicks
- † Optional: construction paper, scissors, markers or crayons

Preparation:

1. If clay is not feasible, participants can complete this activity by cutting a heart out of construction paper and using markers or crayons to write on the heart.

Instructions:

1. Hand out clay and a toothpick to each participant and instruct them to make the clay into the shape of a heart.

- 2. Jesus models how to serve through his ministry. Using the toothpick, write or draw a symbol of a way that we can serve others.
- 3. Allow participants to work on their hearts.
- 4. If completing this activity with paper, invite participants to cut out a heart from construction paper and write on it using markers or crayons.
- 5. Invite participants to share what they put on their hearts.
- 6. These hearts show us what a servant's heart looks like. As we follow Jesus, we strive to have a servant's heart, remembering that when we serve others, we serve Jesus, too.
- 7. If desired, set the hearts aside to dry and paint them during the next class.
