
Lesson #1-31

Explore different languages.

You will need:

† Internet-connected device

Preparation:

1. Find a translation website or app such as Google Translate and type in a simple phrase. Choose a few different languages, and be ready to say or play the website or app's audio.

Instructions:

- 1. Play your message in different languages.
- 2. Language is important to help us understand of what is going on. The message you were hearing just now was (your chosen message), but you were hearing it in (the languages you chose). When I say the message in English

- (demonstrate), you know what I am saying and what I want you to do.
- 3. Today we heard a story about Paul and Barnabas, who traveled and taught about Jesus. When they came to a city called Lystra, they had some communication problems, and had to try to communicate with the people to clear up a misunderstanding.
- 4. Let's listen to a few more sentences, and see if you can guess what they are.
- 5. Type in a variety of simple phrases (older students may enjoy hearing different languages), such as "Jesus loves you," "Read your Bible," "Pray today," or "Tell others about Jesus."
