Write a letter thanking a faith mentor.

You will need:

- † Paper
- † Envelopes
- † Pens or pencils
- † Postage stamps

Instructions:

- 1. Paul wrote a letter to the church in Rome to thank them for doing such a great job sharing their faith, and to encourage them to continue. Who in your life has shared their faith with you? Allow answers and examples.
- 2. Today we will take a moment to write a letter to someone who has been an influence to you in your faith life. It

- might be a parent, a grandparent, a pastor, a friend, or another family member.
- 3. Sometimes it is hard to thank someone. What are some things you might want to say to this person? Allow participants to brainstorm answers.
- 4. Distribute paper and pens or pencils. Encourage participants to write a letter thanking their faith mentor and encouraging them to keep sharing the faith.
- 5. Option: Participants may instead choose to write a letter to younger students to encourage them in their faith walk.
