The Point:

God listens to our prayers.

Responding to God’s Love

BURNING BUSH SNACK

Eat a snack that looks like fire.

You will need:

- † Graham crackers
- † Yellow frosting
- † Red, yellow, and orange candies or sprinkles
- † Paper plates
- † Plastic knives

Preparation:

1. You may want to frost the graham crackers for younger students.
2. Before serving any food, always check with participants or caregivers for students who have food allergies. Provide an alternative if necessary.

Instructions:

1. **Our story today had a burning bush in it. That is not something we get to see in our everyday lives, so we are going to make a snack to remind us of our story.**
2. Distribute a plate, knife, and graham cracker to each student. **We are going to frost our graham crackers first. Then we will sprinkle the candies on top of the frosting to make it look like fire colors.**
3. Allow students to decorate and eat their cracker.
