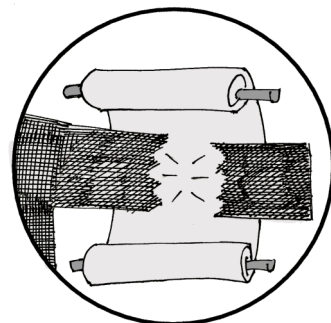


Lesson #2-12

JOSIAH FINDS THE SCROLL

2 Kings 22:1-10, [11-20]; 23:1-3

**Key Verse:**

[Josiah] did what was right in the sight of the LORD, and walked in all the ways of his father David; he did not turn aside to the right or to the left.

2 Kings 22:2

The Point:

We are called to repent when we discover our sin.

Unit Theme (November 12—November 26)

Our Sin, God's Faithfulness

CREATE MY OWN SCROLL

Make a craft with words and images.

You will need:

- † Activity Sheet (see page 2)
- † Paper
- † Markers or crayons
- † Ribbon
- † Scissors
- † Tape

Preparation:

1. Make a copy of the Activity Sheet for each participant.

Instructions:

1. **In our story, the builders were surprised to find the scroll in the temple. Today we are going to make little “good news” scrolls for**

our family and friends, so they can find them and be surprised as well. Hand out Activity Sheets and crayons or markers.

2. Invite participants to choose which words they might want to include on their scrolls, and allow them to cut out the words. Invite them to tape the words on the scroll and decorate with pictures. Remind them that our scrolls should share God's good news. Then ask them to pick someone who might need to see the scroll this week. Help them think of a place they might hide the scroll so that person will find it. Close by handing out pieces of ribbon to tie up the scrolls.
3. The Activity Sheet is designed to help pre-writers “write” their own scroll. Any participants who can write their own message should.
