

Lesson #2-27 THE END OF THE AGE

Mark 13:1-8, 24-37



Key Verse:

"And what I say to you I say to all: Keep awake." Mark 13:37

The Point:

Trusting in Jesus, we can do God's work.

Unit Theme (March 17—March 31) God's Triumph

MAKE AWAKE

Play a game of musical chairs.

Supplies:

- † Music player
- † Chairs

Preparation:

1. Be aware of persons with limited mobility in your class, and create alternative plans if needed.

Instructions:

1. Jesus told his disciples that they must keep awake, because no one knew when God's kingdom would come in power and glory. As a fun way to remember to keep awake, let's play a game of musical chairs.

- 2. Everyone should pull their chairs away from their tables. Make two rows of chairs, back to back. After this is done, take away one chair.
- 3. In musical chairs, you need to pay attention to the music. As soon as it stops, sit down in the nearest chair. One person will be left standing and will be out for the round. For each round, we will take away another chair, until only one vigilant person will be left.
- 4. Remember to be gracious to each other. No pushing or shoving. Anyone showing unsportsmanlike behavior will be out for the round.
