Play instruments to worship.

You will need:

Instructions:

- We worship God because God is good. We worship God because God is great. We are going to worship God. I will say something about God. Then you will repeat after me. After that you can use the table as a drum, use your hand at your mouth to make a horn sound, or clap your hands. We will use words and instruments to worship God.**

 - God has done good things for me. Let us worship God.** Students echo and play instruments.
 - God saved the Israelites from the Egyptians. Let us worship God.** (Echo.)
- We love God because God first loved us.** (Echo.)
 - God created the world and all that is in it.** (Echo.)
 - God sent Jesus to earth for us.** Students (Echo.)
 - God forgives us when we sin.** (Echo.)
 - God provides for all our needs.** (Echo.)
 - God protects us from our enemies.** (Echo.)
- What can you remember that God has done for you? Say it, and we will repeat you and play our instruments. Let us worship God.** Answers will vary.

When the activity is over, say: **We can worship any time by remembering all we know about God and thanking God for being so great.**
