Key Verse:

"But will God indeed dwell on the earth? Even heaven and the highest heaven cannot contain you, much less this house that I have built!" 1 Kings 8:27

The Point:

The temple was a place to connect with God.

Make a prayer board.

Supplies:

- † Construction paper
- † Glue
- † Magazines or photos
- † Scissors

Instructions:

- 1. Solomon's prayer to God was all about others. He prayed for God to forgive them when they reach out to God and be with them whether they were in the temple or somewhere else.
- 2. We also care about others, but sometimes we do not know what to pray for them. We could pray for people's health, physical and

- mental, for good things to happen to them, for situations to be resolved, for them to know God's love, and much more.
- 3. Go through the magazines (or other photos) and cut out pictures of things that you would pray for others. For example, you might cut out a picture of a nurse, either to pray for health care workers or for people who are sick to get better, or both! Glue these pictures to your paper to make your collage prayer!
