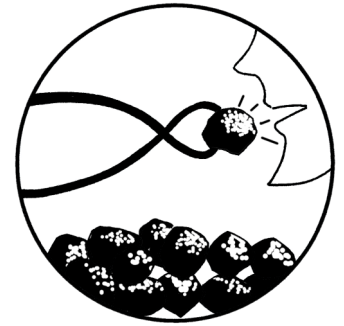


**Lesson #3-11****ISAIAH'S VISION**

Isaiah 6:1-8

**Key Verse:**

“Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, ‘Whom shall I send, and who will go for us?’ And I said, ‘Here am I; send me!’”

**The Point:**

God calls imperfect people to do God’s work.

**WHAT'S MY CALLING?**

*Use clues to identify vocations.*

*Supplies:*

- † Optional: slips of paper, pen or pencil

*Instructions:*

1. In today’s passage, Isaiah accepted his calling as a prophet in a very dramatic situation. We might not receive a vision of smoke, angels, and earthquakes, but God still calls—invites—each of us to different work, whether it is a paid job or other things we do. Let’s play a game about this!
2. Keep the answer to the following question a secret: if you could have any job (when you grow up), what would it be? Optional: You can write a variety of more general jobs/callings on slips of paper and either follow the instructions below or play charades with them.
3. **We are going to play a game called What’s My Calling?** The first player will stand in the front, and the rest of you will ask questions to get clues to help you figure out what job or vocation the player is thinking about.
4. When someone guesses the answer correctly, we will stop and pray for that player to be confident and enabled to do things for God.
5. The person who guessed the vocation correctly becomes the next player to sign in, and the game continues the same way.
6. When the game ends, pray for everyone present.
