The Solution

The Curriculum

Spirit and Truth lessons engage children in active learning by utilizing original skits, stories, and activities to teach the meaning of worship and the liturgical language used in the various settings of the Lutheran liturgies. Half of the lessons walk students through the traditional liturgy and the other half introduce students to the meaning of the major festivals of the church year.

Early Elementary (PK-2nd Grades)

The Early Elementary School lessons engage students with a Bible-based story each week that teaches the theme in a fun, kid-friendly format. Each lesson is reinforced by activities designed with young children's creativity and energy in mind.

Upper Elementary (3rd-6th Grades)

The Upper Elementary School lessons involve the students in teaching each other by acting out an original humorous skit each week. The theme is further emphasized with a short Bible Lesson and engaging activities.
