

Lesson #4-4

Moses: Equipped by God

Exodus 2:23-25; 3:10-15; 4:10-17

Key Verse:

God heard their groaning, and God remembered the covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

The Point:

God blesses reluctant messengers and uses them to bless others.

Unit Theme (September 10 - October 8):

Blessing Others

God blesses reluctant messengers and uses them to bless others.

You will need:

- † Note cards
- † Crayons or markers
- † Optional: music player

During class:

- 1. Sometimes we all feel shy, and that is ok. Just like Moses, we might feel like we are not good at talking, or we do not know what to say, or we are too small and unimportant. But God promises to always be with us, and to help us.
- 2. Today for our worship time, we are going to make cards that we can give to our

friends to help us tell them about God. Take at least one note card, and then write or draw something on it that reminds you of God. What are some ideas of things we could draw? [A dove, cross, the world, church, etc.]

- 3. I am going to turn on some music so you can think and draw. This is a time to work quietly, and to think about God.
- 4. Allow time for students to make one or more cards.
- 5. When they are finished say: You can take these cards home with you and use them to tell others about God. Give them to someone that you think would like to know more about God, and tell them about what you drew and what it means to you.
- 6. Bring your cards with you and we will form a circle. Hold your cards out in front of you while we pray: Dear God, sometimes we are shy and scared and do not know what to say. Bless these cards and help us use them to talk to other people about what you mean to us, and about how much you love us. Amen.
