# **Lesson #4-19** The Messially's Encounter at the Temple John 2:13-25



### Key Verse:

Jesus answered them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up." John 2:19

#### The Point:

Jesus' life, death and resurrection bring life in a way that human actions cannot.

#### Unit Theme (January 7 - January 21): Encountering the Messiah

Build IK Up, Tear It Down

Stack cups to illustrate Jesus' claim about his death and resurrection.

#### You will need:

- **†** Bible
- **†** Plastic cups
- **†** Stopwatch or other time-keeping device

#### Instructions:

- 1. Read today's lesson from John 2:13-25.
- 2. Let's listen closely to the end again and what Jesus says.
- 3. Read John 2:18-22 again.
- 4. The leaders asked Jesus to show them

a sign that he had the authority to drive the moneychangers out of the temple. What did he say? ["Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up.]

- 5. But, the temple took dozens of years to build, so would have sounded crazy to the Jewish leaders.
- 6. Let's do a quick challenge about building and rebuilding.
- 7. Pass out a stack of 21 cups to each table.

## Build K Up, Tear K Down (Cont.)

- 8. You will need someone to serve as the timer at each table using either a watch or phone. Taking turns, start the timer with the cups in one stack. Build a tower with six cups on the bottom, then five, then four, going all the way to one at the top. Then put the cups all back into a stack. Allow each person to have a turn, and see how fast it can be done.
- 9. After all tables have finished, you may choose to ask who had the fastest time.
- 10. It would have been crazy to think of building a whole temple in three days, but Jesus was not talking about the actual temple, he was talking about himself.
- 11. What would make Jesus compare himself to the temple? [God now dwells in Jesus, just as God dwelt in the temple.]
- 12. What is Jesus promising? [That even if they kill him, God would raise him up in three days.]
- 13. Do you think the religious leaders or the disciples understood what Jesus was saying? Why or why not?
- 14. Work together to turn your cups into a cross in the center of your table as a reminder that Jesus has promised that even if he is torn down, he will rise again in three days.
- 15. Jesus' life, death, and resurrection are a lot bigger than the temple. Jesus brings life and shows God's power in a way that human actions could not.
- 16. In Jesus, people will experience God in an even closer way than worshipping at the temple and giving sacrifices to God. In Jesus, God is doing something new!
