

Lesson #4-22**Seeing Abundant Life**

John 9:1-41

**Key Verse:**

“As long as I am in the world, I am the light of the world.”
John 9:5

The Point:

God works even through our brokenness and unbelief to draw us into relationship with Jesus.

Unit Theme (January 28—February 11):

Invitation to Abundant Life

Sight in the Darkness

Identify objects in the dark.

You will need:

- † Pairs of objects in multiple sizes and textures
- † Bags

Preparation

1. Use objects that have interesting features. Some examples might be a measuring cup, dice, acorn, toy car or airplane, banana, an instrument, or a tennis ball. You will need two of each item.
2. Place items in individual bags so they are hidden from students' view.

Instructions:

1. **Today you are going to have to figure out what the objects in these bags are by simply feeling them.**
2. Divide the group into two teams and call one player from each team up. **I will give each player the same object. The first student to guess their object wins a point for their team.**
3. When the game is over, ask: **How many of you found that task difficult? Why? It is amazing how much we depend on our eyesight. When that is taken away from us life can be difficult.**



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
